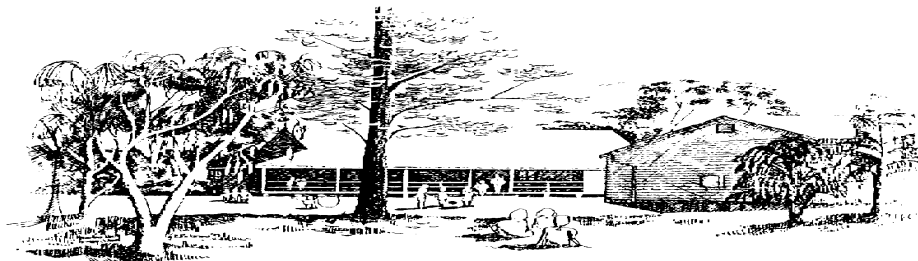

Guitar Lessons

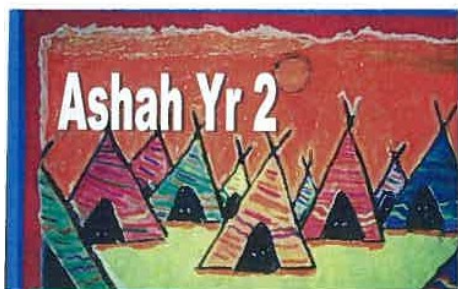
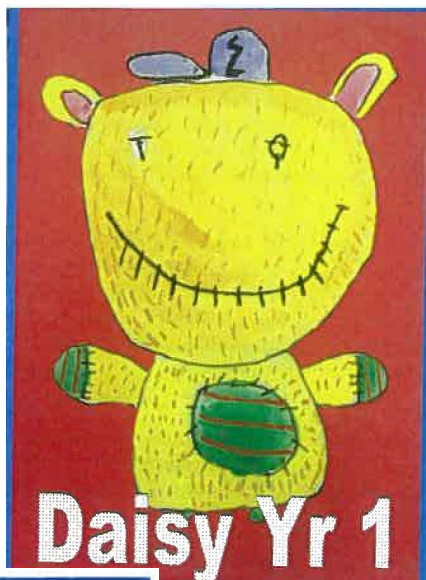
