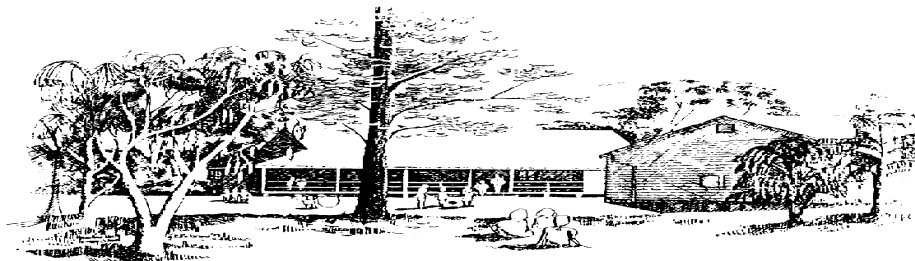

Also grab some beautiful beetroot, spinach, carrots and celery grown with love in the school gardens.

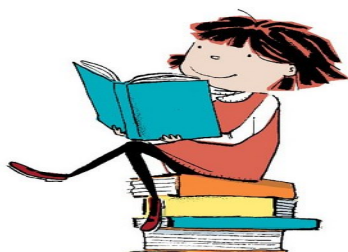

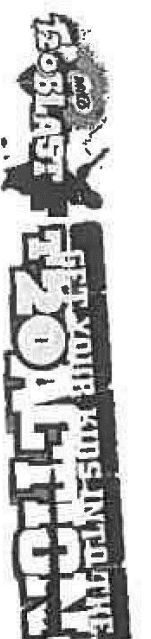
