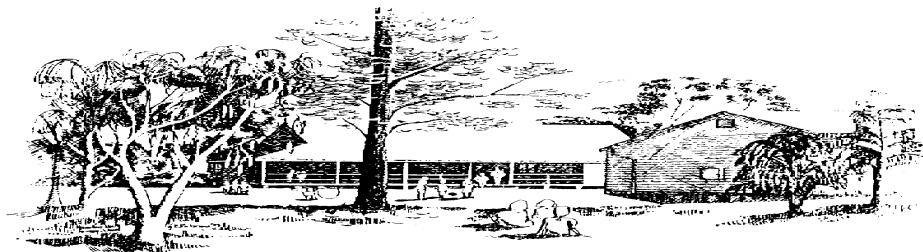

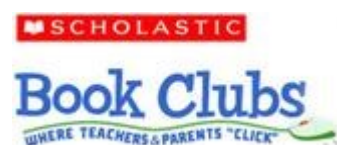


### BOOKCLUB
