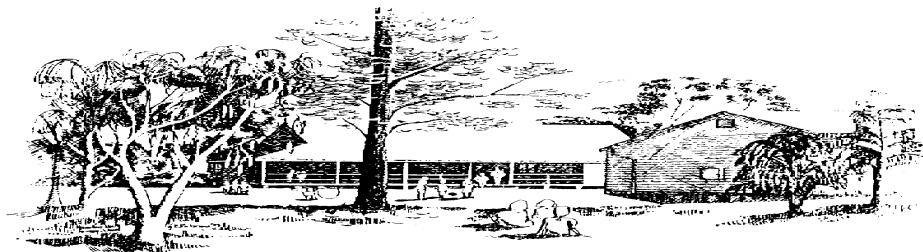

The P & C are asking for donations to make up hampers for their annual Christmas fundraiser.

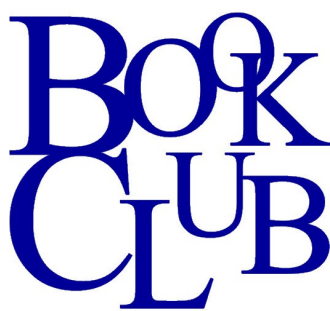


If you are able to donate Christmas gifts, decorations, non-perishable Christmas food items etc, it would be greatly appreciated if you could forward these to your child's classroom.

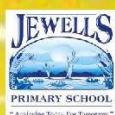
