School Reports

Individual student reports will be sent home by your child's class teacher in Week 10, the last week of this term. You will notice that the report template looks a bit different. This is because we have changed software. The information that is included in your child's report is the same – we are still reporting against the mandatory outcomes for your child's stage of learning. The Maths and English comments will be briefer but will still give you an understanding of how your child is progressing. As was previously the case, the other key learning areas (Science, HSIE, CAPA and PDHPE) are given grades only – not comments. A more in depth account of your child's overall progress and involvement at school will be included in the general comment at the end of the report. Kinder student grades are different to years 1-6 as they are either Working Towards, Working At or Working Beyond in relation to the relevant learning outcomes. This is in line with the Department of Education reporting policy.
